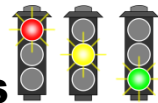

2018 HOSPITALITY

Check your 2018 calendar now and plan to sign up at our next dance for the months you will take your turn. VP's Johnnie and Cordelia are providing a sign up duty roster for you to mark your selections for CA (cake walk), G (2 greeters per regular dance), KD (kitchen duty), and E (early kitchen setup and coffee brewing). If you know when you will be away on trips or extended absences, mark with an X the months you are gone. Johnnie and Cordelia will assign you to various duties if you do not sign up. For example, the kitchen duty requires four people or two couples monthly or 48 people next year. New members are granted a one-year exemption to ensure more dance time. 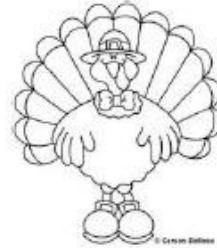
